

Appliance Inventory & Warranty Log

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One line per appliance, at home or in the business. The point is not tidiness but decisions: acting before a warranty expires, and answering repair-or-replace from a record rather than a guess.

Before the warranty expires (tick a month before the end date)

- ☐ Ran the appliance through every programme All modes tested
- ☐ Reported any small faults to the service Left a dated record
- ☐ Photo of the invoice and warranty card is on file
- ☐ Considered any extended warranty offer Rarely worth more than 15-20% of the item price
- ☐ Put the end date in the calendar as a reminder

Three notes

- The warranty runs from the invoice date; for appliances needing installation, keep the installation record too.
- If a symptom began inside the warranty period, being able to show that WITH A DATE ends the argument — note the day you first noticed it.
- If a repair costs more than half a new machine and the appliance is in the last third of its life, repairing is usually a deferred expense.
